## #5 – Night Parking

## An Ordinance to Prohibit All Night Parking During Certain Months

- 1. No person having the custody or control of any vehicle shall stop or cause to be stopped, or park all night, nor more than one hour between the hours of midnight and eight a.m. from November 1<sup>st</sup> to April 15<sup>th</sup>, on any public street or highway in the Town of Rye.
- 2. Any person who violates the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than ten dollars (\$10.00).
- 3. The Chief of Police, or any officer of the Rye Police Department, may cause any vehicle parked in violation of Section 1 of this Ordinance to be removed from the street or highway.

NOTE: On March 10, 1970, Article 25, it was voted to increase the fines levied for violation of any Town Ordinance from \$10.00 to \$50.00 as provided in RSA 31:39.
