

Ordinance #3

Skateboard and Roller Skates Regulations

1. The use of skateboards and roller skates on all public highways, sidewalks and commons within the Town of Rye is prohibited, provided however, that the Chief of Police with advice and consent of the Selectmen, may designate certain streets, roads and ways upon which the use of skateboards and roller skates may be permitted.
2. Violation of this regulation shall subject the person convicted to the maximum penalty provided for the violation of Town Ordinances provided that person be over the age of seventeen (17) years. For the first violation of this regulation by any child seventeen (17) years of age or under, the parents or guardians of such child shall be notified. Upon any subsequent violation, the parents or guardians of such child shall be guilty of a violation as defined by the New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated.
3. This Ordinance is promulgated under the provisions of RSA 41:11 and shall take effect upon its adoption by the legal voters of the Town.

Note: On March 10, 1970, Article 25, it was voted to increase the fines levied for violation of any Town Ordinance from \$10.00 to \$50.00 as provided in RSA 31:39.
